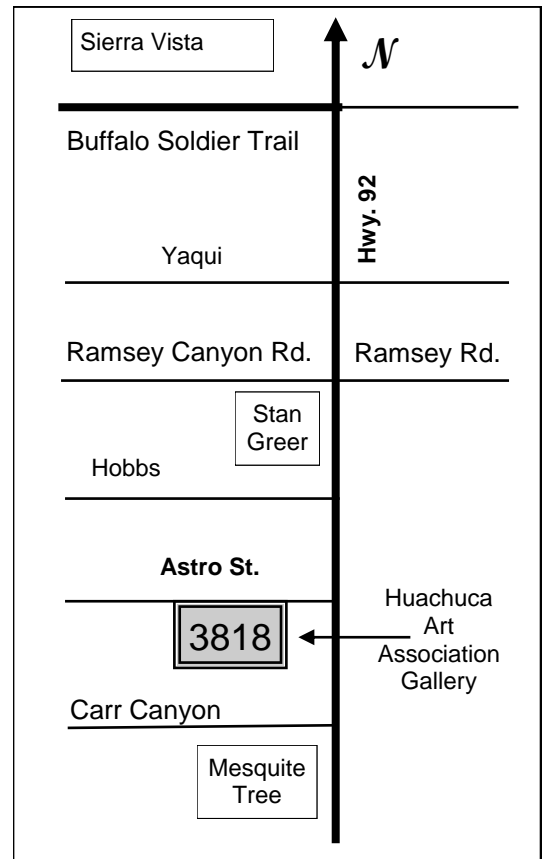

My husband and I feel we dodged a bullet as none of the homes in our wooded area were burned and we're very grateful to the fire crew who worked hard to save homes. the Horsn' Around Non-profit lost all of their horse pasture and one of their horses badly singed.... I hope we'll be able to find ways to reach out to groups like these, helping as we can. Hopefully, later this year we'll be able to provide some charity in the way of a fund raiser for some of these groups.

Bill Willis has had a life of mixed careers before becoming a professional artist. He is a retired Army officer and a former Green Beret. He has owned retail businesses, directed non-profit organizations, taught in and directed a business college and promoted art

shows. Bill finally became a traveling artist entering over 300 shows in the Southwest.

He developed a keen interest in drawing and painting in his early years in Southern Indiana. He sold his first art work, a pastel on butcher paper, to a traveling sewing machine salesman for two dollars. In high school, his talent won many awards in local and regional exhibits and a scholarship to the Art Academy of Cincinnati, but the Korean War interfered. Shortly after joining the Army he married Cathy, his high school sweetheart. He remained in the service for 23 years. During that time he continued painting and his travels in the United States, Europe and Central America enabled him to work and show with a variety of artists and develop his own unique style. Always leaning toward landscapes, water color was the favored media for several years, mostly for reasons of simplicity and not having a place to paint. Oil was always the favorite and that is his medium today. Being an avid hiker and canoeist, Colorado was a great place for landscapes. Bill loves the space of the mountains and desert that he shows in his paintings.

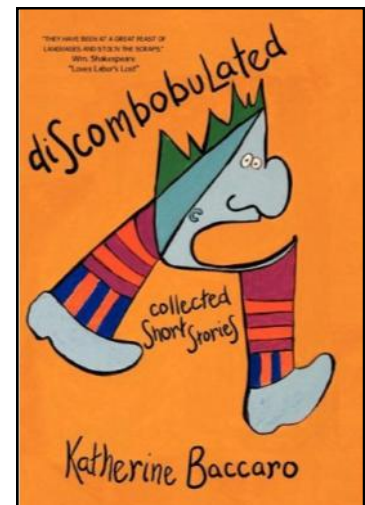

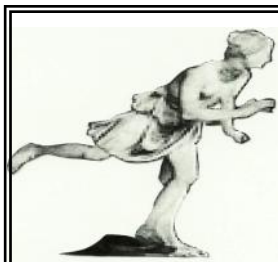

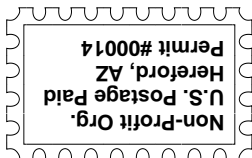
