A Happy New Year And Great News for All! 13 MORE MONTHS IN THE SIERRA VISTA MALL!!

Our two months at the Mall were a great success, thanks to the talent, imagination, hard work, good taste, and expertise of all those who participated, and especially to Elizabeth Line, whose idea it was in the first place. Our thanks go out to her and to her committee of Sue Olivo and Meta Geske, who did so much work and planning to make it happen, and then put in so many hours at the Mall. And our thanks also go out to the many artists who brought in their work to sell, and did the docenting. The artists have been the real winners, and we want to keep that going!

That's the good news. The GREAT news is that Elizabeth has negotiated with the Mall to continue our rental until the end of January, 2013 and the Board has approved the deal. We'll have space for 60 member artists to display their work. There will be a wall charge of \$20 per month, starting in January, or you may choose to pay \$100 for 6 months. The commission on sales due to the HAA will remain at 20%. Each member may hang 5 framed pieces, but as we want to be able to show as many artists as possible, the space allotment for each artist will not exceed 45 sq. ft. The gallery curators may use their discretion in determining when artists have exceeded their space limitations. Artists may submit up to 20 other items, not for hanging, such as fine crafts, pottery, unframed and matted art, jewelry, boxes of cards, etc. All persons showing their work will be required to docent for 16 hrs per month, either in 8hr shifts, or in 4 hr shifts.

The last Wednesday of each month will be the day for paying for wall space and/or trading out art work for the next month. For the month of January, that day will be January 25, from 10:00 A.M.- 1:00 P.M. .We will have one featured artist per month at the Mall Gallery. If you would like to be a featured artist, please submit your name to one of the curators listed below by February 1. Then on Feb 15, the curators will assign an outside source to draw the names of our 10 featured artists for the months of March through December. 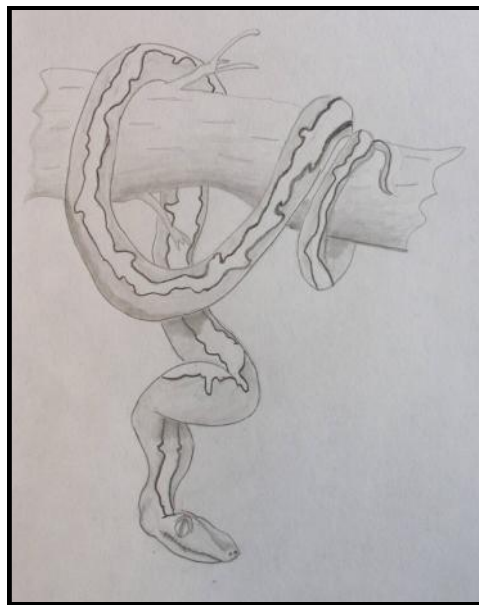
We have continued our art education through out all of 2011 and are looking for exciting opportunities to grow in our class offerings in 2012.

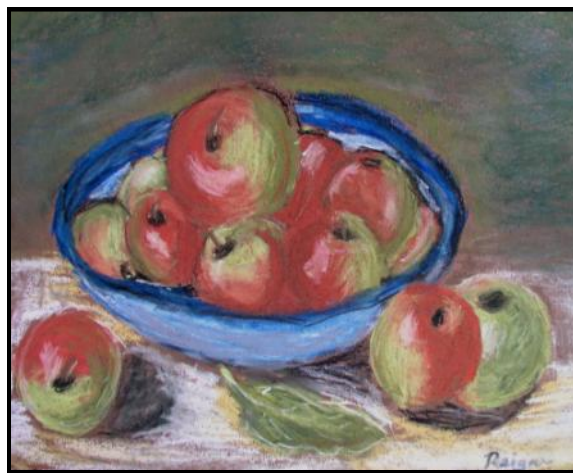

Kudos! **Jesse Hummingbird** The National Museum of the Native American in Washington, D.C., has selected one of Jesse T. Hummingbird's paintings from their collection for inclusion in a new children's puzzle book titled "Where We Live." The book includes eight puzzles from different artists that show different ways American Indian artists use their imaginations to draw where they live. The original image, "Buffalo Boy and His Duesenbird" is one of nine pieces of Hummingbird's in the museum's permanent collection that was donated by one of his collectors, R.E. Mansfield. The piece was also selected as the cover of the book and appears in their national advertising. The book is sold through the museum and can be purchased online at www.nmai.si.edu. This publication comes on the heels of the availability of the second holiday book that Hummingbird illustrated, "Native American Twelve Days of Christmas" for Clearlight Books of Santa Fe. In this second innovative children's picture book, author Gary Robinson creatively adapts the traditional English Christmas carol that Hummingbird brilliantly illustrated. Each of the day's gifts presents a different tribe's custom and presents a deeper explanation of it in an easy-to-understand manner, revealing tribal histories and lifestyles. It is a wonderful companion to last year's "Native American Night Before Christmas" also published by Clearlight. Jesse is a well-known American Indian artist, a member of the Cherokee nation, who lives in Bisbee. He has won numerous awards in regional and national art competitions. He is one of the local artists that has original work displayed at Belleza Gallery in Bisbee and participates in Art in the Park annually in Sierra Vista. 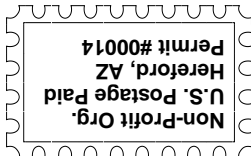
