Angel was born in Germany to a Dynasty of Dancers and Actors and grew up behind the stages of the largest German speaking Theaters and Television sets. She studied Theater for 4 semesters in a famous acting school in Berlin. Angel saw the world at a young age, her camera always ready, she also lived in England, France, and the Canary Islands, Spain. She took all of the English Rock Band "The Shamrocks" publicity photos and her work was

used for posters and one of the group's record cover.

Her photographs, one taken in Taiwan "The Chinese Gardener" and "Inquisitive Minds" (a photo of her dog at her pond), are found in 2 individual Coffee Table Books issued by the International Library of Photography.

Angel came to America almost 30 years ago and lived several years in Alaska. She absolutely loved the Alaskan Wilderness, for her it was a photographer's heaven. Here she also started to garden and to enjoy taking images of wildflowers and wildlife.

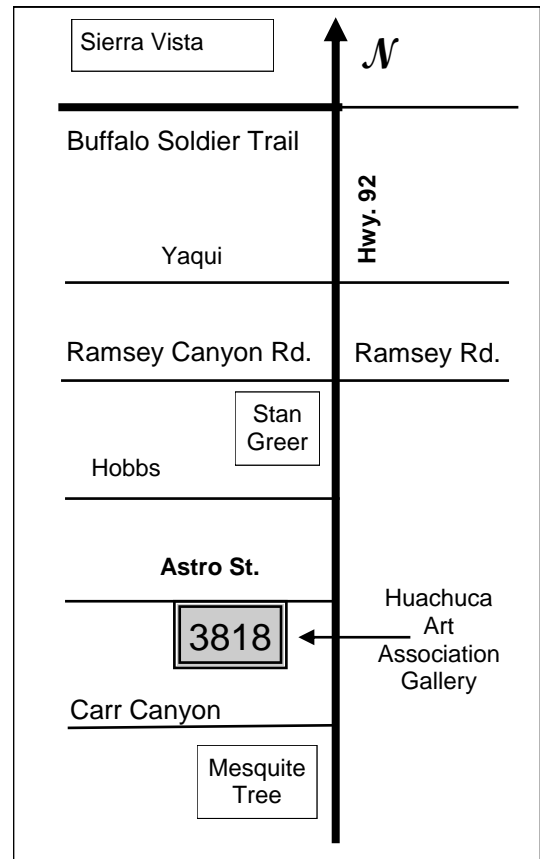
In 1996 the Rutherford's moved to Sierra Vista. In 97 Angel became a Cochise County Master Gardener and a member of the SV Area Gardeners Club. Her qualification is in Desert and Water Gardening. She also has a monthly column in the "Herald" and teaches occasionally Pond building and maintenance classes at Cochise College. For several years she became the photographer for the Cochise Cowboy Poet and Music Gathering.

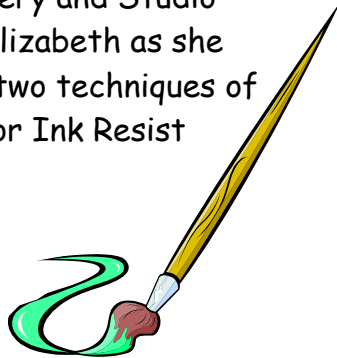

## HANDCRAFTED WORKS OF ART & FINE ART SHOW AND SALE

November 2 to December 31, 2011

At the Mall in Sierra Vista, 2200 El Mercado Loop

This is a non-judged show open to HAA members for displaying of crafts including: illustrated books, jewelry, pottery, leather work, fabric weaving, sculpture and other 3-dimensional works, photography and paintings including bin items, etc. All work must be original creations by the artist. No copies from magazines, books, online images, or photographs (other than photographs taken by the artist unless submitting artist has written permission from the copyright owner). No work done from kits will be accepted. Fee is \$40.00 for up to 20 pieces, a limit of five framed paintings per artist. All sold items, including framed paintings, may be replaced during the show. A 20 percent commission will be retained by the Huachuca Art Association. Each artist or their replacement must document the show, sign up on day of delivery. This is a two-month show; artist may need to sit two to three times during this period.



### Presentation

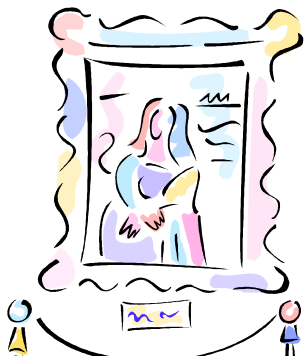
All work must be presented in suitable condition for exhibiting: framed paintings must be wired for hanging, no saw tooth hangers, frames must be in clean, undamaged condition. The committee reserves the right to refuse any damaged items. If possible, please provide display for jewelry. All paintings framed and unframed must have artist name, address, phone number, title, medium and price on the back. Crafts should be identified by cards or tags with artist name, phone, item, price.

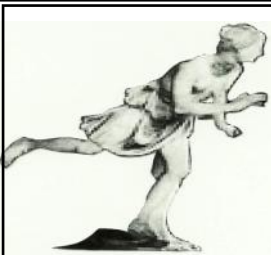

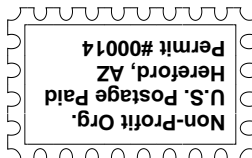
